YOUTH POLICY - HARVEST ROCK

To ensure the safety and security of all attending the Events this Youth Policy forms part of the Conditions of Entry for the Events.

Tickets for persons aged under 18 ("Minors") are only sold in conjunction with tickets for persons aged 18 or over ("Adults"). When purchasing a ticket in conjunction with tickets for Minors an Adult must warrant that they are:

- a family member or responsible guardian of the Minor;
- standing in the position, and undertaking responsibilities of, the parent of the Minor with the parent or guardian's
 consent; or
- the spouse or domestic partner of the Minor.

Minors MUST be accompanied by a responsible Adult holding a valid Adult Event ticket (a "Responsible Adult") when entering the Event and at ALL times whilst at the Event. The Responsible Adult for a Minor is the person aged 18 years of age or older who enters the Event with the relevant Minor and whose name and mobile phone number is recorded on the Minor's wristband at the time of entry.

A maximum of two Minors may be accompanied by a single Responsible Adult.

Minors not accompanied by a Responsible Adult holding a valid Adult Event ticket will be denied entry into the Event or may be removed from the Event.

The Responsible Adult is responsible for the behaviour and actions of the accompanying Minors throughout the Event and must supervise the accompanying Minors during the Event.

It is the obligation of the Responsible Adult to ensure that they and all Minors accompanying them comply with these Terms and instructions issued by Event Staff.

The Responsible Adult must ensure that Minors under their supervision do not engage in any illegal or disruptive activities at any time whilst at the Event. This includes underage drinking, use of illicit substances, or any disruptive or illegal behaviour. Any breach of these conditions may result in the eviction of the Responsible Adult and all accompanying Minors from the Event. The Promoter reserves the right to involve the police in relation to any illegal behaviour.

Any person found to have supplied a Minor with alcohol will have their wristband removed, will be removed from the Event with any accompanying Minors, and police will be notified.

Responsible Adults with accompanying Minors should note that they may not be able to enter certain bars or areas on site with the Minors in their company.

Responsible Adults who become intoxicated (which may be determined by the Promoter or any other appropriately authorised person in their discretion) may be removed from the Event with their accompanying Minors.

All Adult Event ticket holders will be checked for ID at the entry gates.

The following forms of ID will be accepted, in line with the requirements of the Consumer and Business Services (CBS):

- 1. Australian Driver's Licence
- 2. Australian Government-issued Proof of Age Card
- 3. Passport (any nationality)
